Recently Canadian National had cause to put out to tender the construction of a crew accommodation facility to be located in Boston Bar, B.C.

The specifications for this 10,000 square foot facility called for twenty bedrooms to be basically "soundproof" based on recommendations contained in an industry study conducted by Circadian Technologies, Inc., in 1995-96 dealing with crew readiness for duty.

In addition, the building had to be constructed on an extremely tight timeline with the contract being awarded in late June and the building had to be ready for occupancy in early December.
